The Pittsfield Redevelopment Authority (PEDA) is an organization created by the Massachusetts government to redevelop over 50 acres of manufacturing plants that belonged to the former General Electric (GE) facility in Pittsfield, Massachusetts. In 1998, PEDA, GE, and the City of Pittsfield reached a financial agreement that directed funding towards environmental remediation of the property. O'Reilly, Talbot & Okun Associates, Inc. (OTO) has worked on the site since 2005 and is currently working closely with PEDA to abate numerous environmental concerns, including the presence of asbestos and polychlorinated biphenyls (PCBs). A new business park will be constructed in place of the GE plants, and once completed, is expected to bring an economic stimulus to the City of Pittsfield.
